# Graduate Scholarship Program

To strengthen its links with the university milieu, Rio Tinto is proud to present its Graduate Scholarship Program.

**At each participating university, a graduate or post-graduate student will benefit from financial support to pursue studies and carry out research projects.**

#### **Amount awarded**

\$18,000 per university

#### **Participating universities**

- › Laval University
- › McGill University
- › University of Montreal – École Polytechnique
- › University of Quebec in Chicoutimi
- › University of Sherbrooke
- › University of British Columbia

#### **Documents required**

The student must submit a file containing the following:

- › Name of institution where the graduate studies will be pursued
- › Proof of enrollment or acceptance
- › Name of research director
- › Description of the research project including timeline (maximum 4 pages, double-spaced)
- › Official transcripts with results for the entirety of their university studies
- › Two letters of reference from professors or researchers
- › Curriculum vitae

#### **Conditions**

The scholarship application must be received at the graduate or post-graduate Scholarships service at the candidate's university no later than 12 May 2017. Each university will provide Rio Tinto with a short-list of applicants.

#### **Eligibility requirements**

The student must be enrolled or accepted in a full-time study program for a graduate or post-graduate degree.

#### **Preferred areas of activity**

- › Hydrometallurgy
- › Environment
- › Electrolysis
- › Analytical technologies
- › Aluminium metallurgy
- › Modeling and control systems

#### **Terms**

- › The scholarship is offered to students enrolled in first year Graduate studies (Masters) or first and second year Doctorate studies (PhD)
- › The scholarship is nonrenewable, past recipients are not eligible
- › Scholarships will only be awarded to those who meet our eligibility requirements
