ETEC 534 (3) – Create new course

- Friendly recommendation: several learning objectives are not really learning objectives but activities students will complete during the course. These should be revised.
- Assessment criteria must be added for each of the assignments.
- Revisions will be reviewed by the chair on behalf of the committee.

ETEC 581 (3) – Create new course

- Program should consider adding registration restriction to the Calendar entry.
- Learning outcome listed are not really learning outcomes and must be revised. There is good information in the rubrics provided that could be incorporated to reframe these as learning outcomes.
- Grading guidelines are inconsistent with approved grading scale for master's students

and must be revised.

KIN 501 (3) – Create new course
