



Program of Status Quick Guide

| Status | SISC | What it means | What it <u>does not</u> mean |
|--------------------|--|--|---|
| Matriculated | ELIG/REGI | New admit to the degree program, not yet started. They are in good standing with UBC. Will be given a registration appointment | Anything about their registration in courses |
| In Progress | ELIG REGI CONT ELTR | The student is in their program of study because the date is either on or after the declare date. They are in good standing with UBC and continuing in their program, will be given a registration appointment | Anything about their registration in courses |
| Leave of Absence | OLVE | The student is on an approved leave from their graduate program. Will be set back to In Progress automatically when the leave ends | International undergraduate approved leave |
| Pending Completion | - Grad app status: PEND | The student has applied to graduate. The student will not be able to register in this program for any upcoming academic periods | |
| Complete | - | The student has graduated and completed the program. The record is now inactive, no future registration | |
| Discontinued | NELG WTHD | The student <u>chose to/voluntarily stopped</u> that program. This is also the status used for all change of programs. | Any academic or non-academic performance or that the students were required to stop the program |
| Dismissed | NELG Sess Eval: Required to Withdraw | The student was <u>required to stop the program</u> and possibly leave UBC | That the student voluntarily withdrew or stopped their program |
| Suspended | NELG Sess Eval: Suspended | The student is suspended from UBC for academic or non-academic reasons. They can receive a registration appointment and have access to register in course with a start date after the end date of the suspension | |
