Line order / Description / Common problems

Item	Line	Description	Common Problems
1	Thesis Title	Avoid using scientific symbols or Greek letters; spell out the words.	Symbols are included; most symbols can't be catalogued in libraries and will not be searchable.
2	by	Required.	Word is capitalized; it must be lower case.
3	Student Name	Should be the name under which you are registered at UBC. If you would like to use a different name, please let us know.	Students use alternate form of name, or student's name has changed but UBC record has not been updated.
4	Previous Degrees	Optional to list these. If listed, must have degree (abbreviated, e.g. MSc), institution and graduation year.	Incomplete listing.
5	A Thesis Submitted	Must be exactly as shown on sample title page.	No common problems.
6	Degree Name	Spell out degree in full e.g. Doctor of Philosophy, Master of Science, Master of Arts.	Note: no "s" at end of Master.
7	in	Required.	Word is capitalized; it must be lower case.
8	The Faculty of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies	Must be exact.	No common problems.
9	Program	The specific graduate program in which you are registered, in parentheses. Check SSC to confirm your program name. Program name must be in parentheses.	Program name incorrect; "faculty", "department", "school" or "program" included. Theses with inaccurate program names will not be accepted. Name not in parentheses.
10	The University of British Columbia (Campus name)	Must have the campus name (Vancouver or Okanagan) in parentheses underneath.	"The" omitted from The University of British Columbia. Campus name omitted, or not in parentheses.
12	Month and Year	The month and year in which your thesis is accepted.	Month not current
13	Copyright symbol, student name, year	Name must be the same as name at top of title page; year must be current. Do not include the month.	Copyright symbol or year missing Name different from top of title page.
