5) Authorship Policies. It is the policy of this department to assign authorship	based on level of intellectual contribution to
the research, as determined collectively by the research team. The research su	pervisor is usually listed as the last author. If
there are disputes about authorship within the research team, the department	t Head will determine the order of authorship.
Student will be encouraged to publish the result of their research according to	the standards in their field.
6) Work hours. Hours of work and holidays are at the discretion of the studen	t, but will normally meet or exceed
hours per week. A sufficient quantity	of work will be carried out to complete
projects, meet deadlines and achieve in classes.
